If it is after 5:00 p.m. to 8 p.m. go to 1736 Superior 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor for Intake. After 8 p.m. and you are male go to 2100 Lakeside Ave. Shelter-- for women go to 2227 Payne Ave. shelter. Families call 2-1-1.
